Key Terminology

Daily Supply Charge

Daily Supply Charge is a charge that applies for suppying electricity to your premises for each day of the billing period, regardless of how much electricity you use.

kWh

A 'kWh' stands for kilowatt hour and is the unit measurement for your electricity bill.

Key Features of This Offer

Contract Term

The contract term for this offer is for customer who signs up for monthly contract.

General Offer

General offer - receive 15% discount off the electricity consumption. This offer is applicable if the Bill is paid on time (by the date specified on the Bill). On another occasion that the Bill is not paid by the due date, the standard offer rate will be applied. The General Offer is calculated by taking into account the deduction from any applicable government concession or rebate.

Automatic Payment Plan

An option of automatic payment is available and established based on the consumption and automatically deducted on the date you set. Available only from Credit Card or Direct Debit and only available for VISA and Mastercard. Credit Card and Direct Debit payments do not incure any fees.

Online Account Management

Convenient access to the comprehensive information regarding Billing information.

Electronic Billing

Convenient access to Bill through Online Account Management. Online Bill delivery to email is also available. Otherwise, Bill can be posted for \$1.00 (\$1.10 GST inc) per Bill.

Fees

Early Termination or Exit

Termination or Exit fee is not applicable to General Offer. However, 72 hours of advance notice is required of you wish to cancel your contract.

Printed Bill

Printed Bill will incur a fee of a \$1.00 (\$1.10 GST inc).

Connection and Disconnection

Every attempt of connection and disconnection will incur a fee of \$50 (\$55 GST inc.)

Dishonoured Payment

Every declined payment will incur a dishonoured payment fee of \$8.64 (\$9.50 GST inc).

Promotional Offer

Solar feed-in Tariffs

Cooling off Periods

A 10 business day cooling off period applies.
