Terms and Conditions of your SolarMax Plan (NSW, QLD, SA)

1. Applicable Price Plan

SolarMax Price Plan is a non-fixed Term Price Plan. These Terms & Conditions apply to the SolarMax Price Plan.

1.1 Benefits

Under this Price Plan:

- i. electricity exported to the grid between 6:00 PM and 9:00 PM will be credited at the FiT rate of 15c/kWh, up to 30 kWh per day; exports above the 30 kWh daily cap during this period, and exports outside this period, will be credited at the FiT rate of 5c/kWh. All exports outside this period will be credited at the FiT rate of 5c/kWh, with no daily cap; and
- ii. electricity usage between 11:00 AM and 2:00 PM will be charged at \$0/kWh, up to 50 kWh per day. Usage above the 50 kWh daily cap during this period will be charged at the applicable Off Peak rate.

The applicable Peak, EV Off Peak and Off Peak usage rates and time periods are set out in your Offer Summary / Basic Plan Information Document (BPID).

1.2 Eligibility

To be eligible for this Plan:

- i. you must have a smart meter installed at your supply address;
- ii. you must be on a residential tariff without a controlled load tariff; and
- iii. you must be a residential customer, and your supply address must be located in New South Wales, Queensland and South Australia.

You must continue to meet these eligibility requirements while you are on this Plan.

2. Rates/Charges

Other applicable usage rates and charges may change in accordance with your Energy Retail Agreement and applicable Regulatory Requirements. We will notify you of any changes where required by applicable Regulatory Requirements.

3. Important information for you

- All time periods are based on local time at the supply address unless otherwise stated.
- Where applicable, feed-in tariff arrangements are subject to the terms of your Solar Contract.
- The benefits under this Price Plan are subject to eligibility, meter data availability and applicable daily limits.
- These Terms & Conditions must be read together with your CovaU Energy Retail Agreement and your Offer Summary / Basic Plan Information Document (BPID), and any other document expressly stated to form part of your agreement with CovaU.
